



TOEFL Speaking

Question 1

You will be asked to speak about a person, place, object or event.

Describe a place that you like to visit.

Question 2

You will be asked to make a choice.

e.g. Some students study for exams on their own. Others study in groups. Which method of studying do you think is better and why?

Question 3 (Integrated speaking task)

You may read a short passage on the screen, and then you will listen to two people discussing that topic and expressing an opinion. These questions are generally:

- University rules and policies
- University plans
- Campus facilities
- Quality of life on campus

You will then be asked a question about what you have read and heard. This is NOT an opinion task, you are being asked to summarize the information.

Question 4 (Integrated Speaking task)

You will read a passage, listen to part of a lecture and then you will be expected to summarise part of the information.

The topics for this question include academic lectures from:

- Life science
- Social science
- Physical science
- Humanities

Question 5 & 6 (Listening and speaking)

- Question 5 is often based on a social situation. Again you are likely to be asked to summarise a problem and suggest a solution. (Similar to question 3)
- Question 6 is a lecture similar to question 4
